### **MINUTES AS CIRCULATED**

The minutes of the meeting held on November 10<sup>th</sup> 2008 were considered, and after small amendment were approved, prop Mr Boulton, sec Mrs Lovelock, a true record of proceedings and duly signed by the Chairman.

### **MATTERS ARISING**

Re flooding issues; a representative from Lindsey Marsh Drainage Board will meet with the Chairman and inspect the river. Re flooding outside the Rectory; drains have been jetted and an investigation to be made re cause; could be from damage to drain on Maddison Lane when street lamps instated. With reference to lighting on Chapel Lane – two quotes received for installation of light to church wall, from Tony Lawrie Electrical and Graham Sharp Electrical. TLE quote best price at £392.84. To go ahead, prop by Mr Blanchard sec Mr Oliver. Notice of Refusal of Planning Permission has been received re Mr R Oliver on Field Farm. Matters at Stanwood not finalized, lorries no longer parked in the orchard area, but orchard and land has not been reinstated, therefore situation being monitored.

### **CORRESPONDENCE**

The Chairman has complained by fax and phone re material being used by Highways on icy roads 'is useless' and in some respects makes matters worse. The Chairman thanked Mr & Mrs Callaway for attending a RACOL meeting on behalf of the P.C. and for reporting back useful information.
