MINUTES AS CIRCULATED

The minutes of the meeting held on May 11th 2009 were considered, and approved as a true record of proceedings and duly signed by the Chairman.

MATTERS ARISING

Both Thorpe Farm and Stanwood to be discussed later in meeting

CORRESPONDENCE

Re Stanwood – no further correspondence has been received, in hands of ELDC legal department.

Re Thorpe Farm – no further correspondence, Skendleby currently taking up. LCC Transport briefing – includes a contact list and details regarding delivery of Highway Services to be held at Chairman's house. ELDC – pre application advice details re fees for discretionary advice, Mrs Gorst suggested there are more details on website. Planning application received from Dalby Hall Organic Farms re erection of an agricultural machinery workshop and store at Minster Farm, Partney Road, Dalby – plans circulated to councillors pre meeting – no objections. Really useful handbook – website provide by LCC re local services e.g. grant funding, library, children services etc. ELDC will be joining the 'Keep Britain Tidy' campaign re vehicle related litter and will be asking members of public to report on incidents of littering from vehicles. Re 'Trees for Lincolnshire Communities' – discussed whether we should order max number of trees and plant on by-pass. Mr Oliver to discuss with Mr D Hudson. The landlords of the Red Lion have had trouble with broken glass and rubbish left in the pub yard and have found it hard to discuss with recycling contractor. Unless they receive a better service and less misuse they will have them removed. The many isolated incidents of vandalism over the past few months have been reported by Mr Hudson and discussed with PCSO Pollard the local beat officer who will follow it up and hold 2 public surgeries in the Victory Hall 28th July and 26th August in the evening; there has been a good response to the note put in the 'Contact' asking for information.

ACCOUNTS TO PAY & APPROVAL OF ACCOUNTS TO DATE

There are no accounts to pay. Mrs Middleton presented the accounts. Accounts adopted prop. By Mrs Dawson sec by Mrs Lovelock. The annual governance statement was approved by the council.

ANY OTHER BUSINESS

It is proposed that the green bin collection will be postponed between 1st November and 31st March – a cost saving exercise. ELDC feel there will not be an increase in fly tipping. Mrs Gorst stated that there had to be a £2 million budget cut. Suggested that dustbin lorry could visit Spilsby once a month for people to take green waste.

PUBLIC SESSION

Residents have requested a kissing gate replace the stile onto the field behind the school. The footpath which goes between the properties of Mr Gill & Mrs Pennock appears to be obstructed due to a wooden fence. A letter will be sent to follow up with ELDC. Re 'Councillors Community Grant' Mrs Gorst has a small grant which she is able to donate to a community project. It cannot be a church or religious group.
