### **MINUTES AS CIRCULATED**

The minutes of the meeting held on September 14<sup>th</sup> 2009 were considered, and approved as a true record of proceedings and duly signed by the Chairman.

### **MATTERS ARISING**

Thorpe Farm – the latest information from C.C.Colin Davie is that a special team is formulating an investigation. Re: cemetery and valuation of assets – the P.C. need to submit proof of care of the cemetery and investigations are ongoing to find early paperwork concerning village history to establish ownership of the cemetery and its value. Councillor Davie spoke to the highest authority regarding Footpath No 354, their report and decision still stands. Mrs Gorst's report stated that the matters re Stanwood are in the hands of the Legal Services and they may decide it expedient not to take matters further as the main issue of the lorries are no longer being parked on the site and it could be difficult and expensive to get the other issues put right. The cable in Chapel Lane was repaired within twelve hours of the last meeting by EON. Mr Lovelock reports that information gained on the Best kept Village/ Britain in Bloom competition run by the RHS requires community groups and backing by local businesses, a decision to book and hold a meeting in the village hall inviting all interested parties to attend. Suggestions made to the Chairman that the bottle bank could be sited in the car park to be followed up.
