### **MINUTES AS CIRCULATED**

The minutes of the meeting held on January 28<sup>th</sup> 2010 were considered, and approved as a true record of proceedings and duly signed by the Chairman.

### **MATTERS ARISING**

The chairman explained the phases of work to be carried out to power cables in Partney by Eon starting early April. Re request to supply a grit bin at Hudson Close, the County Council unable to supply or maintain as Hudson Close under the jurisdiction of Lynx Homes – to be contacted.

### **CORRESPONDENCE**

Information from Mr Hunt at Sills & Betteridge solicitors shows that the cemetery as Parish asset must be registered with Land Registry. As it is a first registration notice to be served to both County Council and Parish Council. Notice of refusal of Planning Permission received re erection of a detached house at Field Farm, Mr Oliver. Flooding Issue – Lyndsey marsh Drainage Board – chairman had previously not received any response on follow up to request made now has received two letters. The chairman has now met with the legal representative for the Environment Agency, also their engineer at Dalby Beck – the outcome being an Application for Consent for altering the water course to be made and no fee to be made. Mr Hudson waiting for notice to proceed with the work. Notice of planning Permission received from Mr & Mrs Ford at Stanwood, Skegness Road to 'change of use of land to provide an extension to the existing domestic curtilage'. The Parish Council agree that the application is invalid as contrary to planning procedure. Letter from Mr Stockdale received re alteration to stile on Glebe Field behind Rectory. Green Waste collection to be resumed. Neil Dowlman Architecture sent letter of thanks for presentation re proposed redesign of Partney Filling Station.
