### **MINUTES AS CIRCULATED**

The minutes of the meeting 17<sup>th</sup> July 2006 were approved as a true record and duly signed by the Chairman.

### **MATTERS ARISING**

An incorrect pricing and location details has been received from the ELDC re the proposed footpath lighting. Nothing more has been advised re 'finger signs'. Mr Colin Davie is still making enquiries re Spilsby School Roof. At the archaeological site, the stone and brass plaque are now in position. The Chairman thanked Mr Callaway for instating the oak post and board. Mr Callaway has written a letter with regard to having all future Ordnance Survey maps showing the archaeological site. The Chairman has sent a letter of thanks to Mr Rob Atkin, the Senior Archaeologist and included information re the ploughing of the Fair Field. With ref to the provision of litter bins at the bus stop and Partney Shop. ELDC state that they have insufficient funds to provide them. They suggest that the Parish Council purchase them and the Council will empty them. The Chairman will write a letter to the owner of Partney Shop, as Mrs Marsh may assist in the matter. Re 'Shaping the Future of East Lindsey' reply date not specified, therefore too late for meeting: to be addressed for revised new edition. LCC response to handrails on Hardings Lane - not dangerous but bolts need re-tightening. LCC will re-site salt bins to near wall on opposite side of road. LCC have responded to request of removal of 'May Gurney Scheme' sign boards, they have been removed. Re request for 'Speed Indicator Device' on bypass; now on waiting list and volunteers (trained) are needed to use the system.

### **CORRESPONDENCE**

It was reported to the Parish Council that vandals have attacked the cemetery. The Chairman obtained evidence of the desecration/damage and contacted Police Headquarters at Nettleham.

### **CEMETERY CHARGES**

An increase has been discussed, but in general all agree that the charges should be reviewed in twelve months time. Proposed by Mrs Dawson. Seconded by Mr Callaway.

**ACCOUNTS TO PAY & APPROVE ACCOUNTS TO DATE**

All agreed to approve payment Fixed Audit Fee £45.00 + commission fee £5 + VAT 17.5% £8.75 = Total Fee £58.75. Details of accounts circulated and approved and adopted

**ANY OTHER BUSINESS**

The Commercial Council of Lincolnshire have a scheme where they are giving re-conditioned computers to Parish Councils, which will also be serviced and maintained. Chairman will put PC on waiting list. Bottle bank in pub yard accessibility discussed.
