MINUTES AS CIRCULATED

The minutes of the meeting held on 15th January 2007 were considered and approved as a true record and duly signed by the Chairman.

MATTERS ARISING

It is noted that the drain in Hardings Lane is now clear. The 'Services Only' sign at Partney Pumps not yet done. Measuring of the wall is being undertaken for the siting of the new finger signpost. A notice from ELDC confirmed that there is an unauthorised change of use of orchard and paddock, into a lorry park at Stanwood, Scremby Road, Partney. It is confirmed that the pedestrian gate has now been repaired.
