MINUTES AS CIRCULATED

The minutes of the meeting held on 26th November 2007 were considered and approved as a true record and duly signed by the Chairman.

MATTERS ARISING

There is to be a meeting with the PCC and Victory Hall regarding security lighting.

CORRESPONDENCE

Full planning Permission granted to C E Middleton. Refusal of Planning Permission re Mr Seymour, Partney House as adverse effect on setting. Ref 'Provision of Sandbags' – the bags have now been delivered, awaiting sand delivery. Following the severe summer flooding events of 2007 a 'Parish Emergency Plan'/ Directory has been issued from ELDC and Mr S Oliver and Mr M Lovelock will be flood wardens to the Parish. Requests for Street Collections from RAF Association Wings Appeal, British Legion Poppy Appeal and Marie Curie Cancer Appeal approved. Mr Lovelock reports that a 100% community grant is available for the provision of a bus shelter, the site has yet to be agreed, and planning permission applied for. Site to be discussed with the landlord of the Red Lion, although objection raised by member of the public present.

Three interest parties have put forward tenders. Sothar Wood Garden Services, Welton Garden Services, P E Middleton. After discussion it was considered that the most competitively priced and quality work – Mr Middleton. Mrs Dawson proposed acceptance of Mr Middleton seconded by Mr Blanchard.
