MINUTES AS CIRCULATED

The minutes of the meeting held on 12th May 2008 were considered and approved as a true record of proceedings and duly signed by the Chairman.

MATTERS ARISING

The Chairman thanked Mr & Mrs Lovelock for a well organised community litter pick/ tidy up 'session' in the village. Grass cutting and mowing has been carried out in the village and is reported to be sufficient for the moment.

CORRESPONDENCE

Notice of introduction of 'Area Response Teams' from the Divisional Highways manager who will be undertakings small highways works and maintenance Mr Ford, Stanwood, Partney – lorry park appeal has been dismissed. ELDC Dog Wardens to carry out micro chipping sessions. Venues requested. Mr Dunkley has paid for a plot in cemetery. LCC notice received of temporary Road Closure re road patching & surface at Dalby 11.08.08 – 8.9.08. The Chairman has attended a site meeting on May 22nd at the filling station with the Road Safety Partnership representatives to discuss all road safety issues at that area. The Chairman reported o discussions with Mr Hall at the LCC Highways Lighting department and obtained useful information on the subject – the sub-committee will be able to report at the next full Council meeting. BT propose to re-align payphone provision as Partney payphone is listed for possible removal – a response from the PC is requested – PC members agree that a request to retain the phone box be put forward as it is a 'life line' for some people. In response to notification from the Chairman ref recent "Effluent, A16 Dalby" a Highways Officer (ELDC) to carry out inspection of the site – the Chairman sent letters to four departments, further letters also sent with accompanying photographs of site – there has been no response received from the Environmental Health department – the matter discussed at length by members who agree that the Chairman should telephone Mrs S Gorst – ELDC District Councillor – also County Councillor Davie and request they deal with the matter forthwith as most urgent – if unsatisfactory response, the press to be notified. Mr Leverton, Sausthorpe Road Farm has been refused Planning Permission re location on the A158 and speeding vehicles with consequent danger and interruption to the detriment of highway safety.

PLANNING APPLICATION

Planning Application received from Mr A Middleton to carry out alterations and extend to existing house at Dalby Grange. Parish Councillor Mrs E Middleton 'declared an interest'. PCs had 'no comments' and fully supported the application. The members also had 'no comments' re the Planning Application put forward by Mr Seymour, Partney House, to erect a domestic double detached garage/workshop, therefore support the application. A letter and planning details have been received from Humberts Leisure on behalf of their client who requests the Parish Council's views on the proposal to erect six log cabins off Monks Lane (green lane) in Partney – the outcome after discussion is that the Parish Council is not initially in favour.
