

A meeting of the Partney & Dalby Parish Council held at Partney Victory Hall on Monday 10<sup>th</sup> November 2008 at 7.30pm

### **PRESENT**

### **APOLOGIES**

Apologies received from Mr N Blanchard

Mr Phillip Middleton welcomed to the Parish Council by the Chairman and officially registered and signed the Declaration of Acceptance. Mr Middleton was co-opted on the Council being the only applicant to fill the vacancy created by Mr Pearson's resignation.

### **MINUTES AS CIRCULATED**

After slight amendment to the minutes requested by Mrs Dawson, the minutes of the meeting held on 15<sup>th</sup> September 2008 were considered and approved as a true record of proceedings and duly signed by the Chairman.

### **MATTERS ARISING**

A letter received from LCC dated 30<sup>th</sup> September 2008 re Effluent on A16 Dalby Hill states that the landowner concerned has been requested to clear the site up. It is reported that after recent rainfall the drain is not running. Mr Ford at Stanwood had until 14<sup>th</sup> October to appeal and has until 25<sup>th</sup> November 2008 to comply with the planning office 'Enforcement Notice'. The bank is to be given notice that in future all statements / communication is to be sent to Mrs E Middleton, treasurer. Information re street lighting in Partney has just arrived, therefore will discuss at next meeting. Public Telephone Box – a TV campaign launched and a researcher came across the chairman's letter after which interviewed Mr Don Spence, an ex-prisoner of war who depends on the local public telephone. The Council agree that the chairman should keep pressing the matter of larger pipes being installed in the areas at Partney Beck bridge near the Petrol Pumps, and the Dalby Beck bridge leading out of Partney on the old A16. The chairman sent details to LCC John Jaines, Highways Officer, including a detailed map. Mr Lovelock reports that the water level in the beck has been very high again. It is reported that the Chapel Lane footpath was re-surfaced the day following the last meeting. The chairman has requested a quote for supply and fitting a light to church wall. Mr Lovelock spoke to Stagecoach re re-routing of the buses – idea has been shelved due to EU regulations concerning driver hours.

### **CORRESPONDENCE**

A form received from ELDC 'Survey of Parish Community Facilities' to be completed and returned. Notice received of forthcoming roadworks on A16 between Partney and Spilsby starting early December 2008. Invitation received to attend East Lindsey Town and Parish Assembly. A notice of planning application from Mr R Oliver to build a residence at Field Farm, Partney. The council, apart from Mr S Oliver who declared an interest,

agreed that the dwelling would be an asset to the village and therefore supported the request prop by Mrs Dawson sec Mr J Boulton.

Accounts circulated and discussed. Audit fee £82.25 paid. Mr Boulton prop adopt accounts as presented sec Mr Lovelock.

Suggestions made regarding re-siting of bus stop by Mr Lovelock. Mr Oliver suggested using a button system to request a bus to stop at the existing bus shelter.
