### **MINUTES AS CIRCULATED**

The minutes of the meeting held on July 22<sup>nd</sup> 2010 were considered, and approved as a true record of proceedings and duly signed by the Chairman.

### **MATTERS ARISING**

Mr Lovelock is due to meet with a representative of Lincs Wolds Countryside Agency on 11<sup>th</sup> October re funding and design for the village noticeboard/sign. The ELDC will add to their list the 'siding back' of the pathway (public) outside Partney House. Information from ELDC 'Streetscene' department has been received re a proposed bottlebank station. The P.C. has not yet made a decision. The chairman has not yet received a response from LCC Executive Director re speeding traffic at Partney Pumps, will write again.

### **CORRESPONDENCE**

Further to the chairman's request to the Environmental Agency to de-weed and remove trees in the Langton, Partney & Dalby becks, de-weeding has now taken place. Free trees for Parish Councils, the deadline for requests is 30<sup>th</sup> October. Rates demand notice for the cemetery 2010/11 – notice of credit of £5.68 received. The ELDC have given notice that due to a lack of support for the 'mobile library' van, the service may be withdrawn in some areas. An application for Planning permission from Mr R Oliver received – proposed erection of a house on the site of an existing house and outbuildings at Field Farm, Skegness Road, Partney. No objections from P.C. members. Mr Oliver's appeal on previous plans submitted was unsuccessful.

### **ACCOUNTS TO PAY & APPROVAL OF ACCOUNTS TO DATE**

Mrs Middleton presented the accounts. No accounts to pay – adopted – prop Mrs Dawson, sec Mr Lovelock.

### **ANY OTHER BUSINESS**
