Minutes:

A meeting of the Partney & Dalby Parish Council was held at Partney Victory Hall on Monday 12th September 2011 at 8.00 p.m.

Minutes as circulated

Minutes were agreed and signed by the Chairman.

Matters Arising

1. **Stanwood** – the Chairman read out an 8-page letter dated 11/07/11 from ELDC stating that they would be taking action: letter was also displayed for all to read.
2. **Broadband** – the Chairman reminded attendees about the online download speed survey being collated by Mick Lovelock: in addition an email from Cllr Davie was read which gave information about the Government grant to address low broadband speeds – email to be forwarded to ML for action (forwarded 12/9/11 CFC).
3. **Complaint about Royal Mail** – the Chairman has written on 23/8/11 to the Complaints Department at Peterborough but as yet, no response.
4. **Smell from pig farm** – the Chairman reported that he had written a letter dated 23/8/11 and had called to see Mr Hawkes Snr who was apologetic about the excessive pig smell: Mr Hawkes assured the Chairman that everything would be done to ensure compliance. In addition, telephone contact numbers were given by Mr Hawkes and read out at the meeting (Simon 01790 752267 or 07836 588455) if incidents again arise. These numbers were confirmed by CFC by email 12/9/11).

In addition, the Chairman reported that a neighbouring Parish had raised other concerns highlighting some other areas and issues around the pig farm. No response had been received at the date of the meeting. Chairman to monitor and report back.

5. **Maps** – the Chairman was pleased that additional maps had come to light which formed part of the history of the village of Partney; Mrs Dawson suggested the map should be framed and hung in the Victory Hall.
