

JOSEPH STOREY

Joseph Storey was born in 1876 in Horncastle. His father Dawson Storey had been born in Partney and worked as a Malster. In 1901 the family lived at 1 The Staunch, Horncastle.

By 1911 the family had moved to 1 Waterside, Horncastle. His father Dawson had died in 1902 at the age of 62. Joseph was working as a Bricklayer/Labourer.

He served as a Private in the 7th Lincolnshire Regiment during the First World War. This was a service battalion formed in Lincoln in 1914. It first landed in France at Boulogne on 14th July 1915.

Joseph is recorded as an absentee voter on the 1918 Electoral Register for Partney which shows his normal place of abode as 'near Church'. Mary Storey is included on the Register at this address.

He was awarded the British War Medal and the Victory Medal. He was also awarded the Silver War Badge.
